Professionals are encouraged to send 100 copies of anything they want included in the Guild packets with their registration. Guilds are invited to bring opportunity quilts and their own means of displaying the quilt.

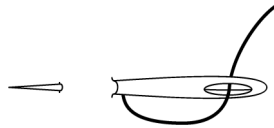

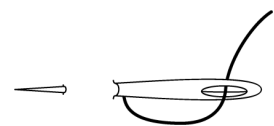
